Dear Parents,

This year students in grades 4-6 are being offered the opportunity to learn a musical instrument. This year we are offering: Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet and Drums. We are very excited to be able to offer this opportunity and there has been a great deal of interest expressed by students.

Instrumental lessons will take place once a week for 30 minutes. If your child would like to participate it will be a year-long commitment. There will be opportunities for public performances on assembly and performances at the Murwillumbah Eisteddfod, as well as at the end of year. Due to the nature of there is a cap on the number of students for each instrument so slots will be given on a first come first served basis.

Your child has expressed an interest in learning an instrument and has requested to be included in the group. The loan expectations for the instrument are:

- The equipment should be used only by the student to whom it is lent and by no other person.
- Every care and attention should be given to the equipment during the period of loan and accept responsibility for the care of the named instrument and agree to pay for any loss or damage.
- The equipment is returnable upon demand from the school at any time for inspection, repair, adjustment or for any other cause.
- Loss or damage of any equipment on loan must be immediately reported to the school.
- Equipment must be returned by the student to the school by the date specified in this loan agreement.

The cost of lessons are as follows:

Flute Clarinet and Trumpet:

St Anthony is fortunate to have a selection of flutes that can be rented at a rate of \$25 per student per year this includes the price of their copy of "Standard of Excellence book 1" music lesson book.

Class sizes limit: Flutes- 6, Clarinets-3 Trumpets 4

- Drum students must bring in \$40 dollars, this will cover the PURCHASE cost of: a DIXON drum pad, A SET OF Vic Firth sticks and a copy of Standard off Excellence Percussion book.
- Class size limit at 4.

There are many benefits to learning a musical instrument including: improving memory skills, teaching perseverance, creating responsibility and a sense of achievement, nurturing creativity and expression, improving coordination, maths skills, listening skills, reading and comprehension skills and social skills.
